Athy College has also been selected by Junior Cycle for Teachers as a pilot school for professional development in Short Course for Coding. Training will be provided for by Lero, Intel and JCT. Two teachers recently completed the CTwinn project with Trinity College Dublin and Queen's University Belfast.</p>
